Basic Water Park Information & Ideas to Consider Before You Begin



You will need to consider several items before you begin:

- If you do not like water parks or have never been to one you will need to conduct some research before beginning
- Rules
 - General
 - Public health and safety
 - Each attraction
 - Etc.
- Attire
- Facilities available
- Hours of operation
- Costs of various attractions

Example from Six Flags Hurricane Harbor

The following information will help ensure a safe and enjoyable visit to Six Flags Hurricane Harbor. First, remember to apply sunscreen before your visit. To help prevent heat exhaustion, avoid overexertion and drink plenty of water.

WATER PARK RULES

- Children should not be left unattended
- Height, weight, and health restrictions are strictly enforced
- Non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult who can swim
- Casts are not allowed on slides, or most attractions
- Do not wear eyeglasses or jewelry in pools, as they may not be retrievable if lost during operation
- Face masks are not allowed
- Running or diving is not allowed anywhere in the waterpark
- There is no smoking, except in designated areas at the Tiki Bar and at Treasure Chest
- Capacity is limited, so the park may not be available to all guests during peak times

APPROPRIATE ATTIRE

In order to participate in waterpark activities, guests must wear lined swimsuits. Street clothes, cutoff shorts, denim shorts or athletic clothing is not allowed in any water areas. In addition, swimwear with buttons, snaps, rivets or zippers is not allowed.

- Shoes are not allowed in any attraction
- Aqua socks are not permitted on slides
- Infants' diapers may be changed in restroom changing stations only
- Toddlers are required to wear swim diapers
- Swimsuits are only allowed in Six Flags Hurricane Harbor, and must be appropriate for our family environment
- Shoes, proper shorts and cover-up attire is required when returning to the theme park

SEASON PASS PERKS

Season Pass Holders will be the first in to Hurricane Harbor at the scheduled opening time. Season Pass Holders also enjoy no wait access to Hurricane Harbor. Just follow the signage at the Hurricane Harbor entrance and slide in ahead of everyone else. No wait access is subject to Hurricane Harbor capacity.

SHOWER FACILITIES

Shower facilities are located near the waterpark entrance, so it's easy for you to change and shower before or after your visit to Six Flags Hurricane Harbor.

LOCKERS

Electronic, PIN CODE Access, lockers are available for rent in Hurricane Harbor's Change Room Area and accept both dollar bills and credit cards. All lockers are cleared out each night when Hurricane Harbor closes. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

LIFE VESTS

Any guests not confident in their swimming abilities should use life vests, a limited number of which are available free of charge, near Aruba Tuba Rentals. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved personal life vests are permitted.

FIRST AID

A First Aid Station is located across from the Wahoo Racer.

LOST CHILDREN

Pages cannot be broadcast in Hurricane Harbor, except for medical emergencies, so please prearrange a meeting time and place with your children in case they get lost. Children who are separated from their parties will be taken to Lost Parents, located next to Aruba Tuba Rentals.

TUBE RENTALS

Single and double tubes are available for rent at Aruba Tuba Rentals, located near the changing and showering facilities. For your safety, no personal recreational flotation devices are allowed in Six Flags Hurricane Harbor.

WATER PARK RULES

- All persons entering Pool Area must pay admission.
- Swimming is permitted only when an authorized lifeguard is on duty.
- The lifeguard on duty shall enforce all pool regulations.
- The lifeguard on duty has the authority to suspend pool privileges if rules are violated.
- During Open Plunge times, there will be a minimum of one 5 minute break per hour during which the entire pool will be cleared.
- All accidents, however minor, must be reported to the lifeguard on duty and an accident report must be filed that same day.
- Absolutely No Children under 8 years of age will be admitted unless they are accompanied in the water by a responsible person 14 years of age or older.
- Children under 14 years of age are not allowed in deep end of pool unless they can pass a deep water swim test administered by a lifeguard or lifeguard supervisor.
- A cleansing shower must be taken before entering the pool.
- No street clothes or shoes are allowed on the deck.
- No smoking, food, drinks, or glass containers are allowed on the deck or in shower area.
- Inappropriate swim wear may be disallowed by lifeguards.
- Infants must wear swimsuits if in the pool. APPROVED SWIM DIAPERS ARE REQUIRED IF THEY ARE TAKEN IN THE WATER. Approved swim diapers may be purchased at the Water Park Office.
- No band aides or people with open wounds or stitches are allowed in the pool.
- Flotation devices or toys are allowed only in shallow water (NOT BEYOND 3 FEET).
- No running on deck, playing tag, pushing, or shoulder riding is allowed in or around the pool.
- Sitting or hanging on the rope is prohibited.
- Playing on ladders is prohibited.
- Spanish Fork City is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Locker rental is available. Lock up your valuables. Don't leave them on the deck or in an unlocked locker.
- PLEASE do not drink the pool water.
- PLEASE do not swim when you have diarrhea and for 2 weeks after.

- PLEASE practice good hygiene. Take a cleansing shower before swimming and wash your hands after using the toilet or changing diapers.
- PLEASE take your kids on bathroom breaks or check diapers often.
- PLEASE change diapers in a bathroom and not at pool side.
- PLEASE wash your child thoroughly (especially the rear end) with soap and water before swimming.
- Special Note: A "cleansing shower" means the cleaning of the body surfaces with soap and water to remove any matter that may wash off into the pool while swimming including fecal matter, lotion, hair products, makeup and deodorant.

DIVING BOARD RULES

- One person at a time on the diving board.
- Dive straight off the end of the boards.
- No double spring off the boards.
- Be sure the person in front of you has exited the pool before diving.
- No hanging from the diving boards.
- Diving into the pool from the deck is prohibited.

WATER SLIDE RULES

- Go down the slide in sitting position or on back.
- No trains.
- No head first.
- No STANDING or playing in the SPLASH DOWN area.
- Use certified PFD's (personal flotation device) if you can't touch bottom.
- Wait until the person in front of you is 1/2 way down the slide before you start down.

Park Rules

- Summer Fun Water Park is a "Family" oriented facility. Our rules are intended to provide both a safe and healthy atmosphere for you and your children.
- Our rules are not just "Guidelines," Summer Fun Water Park reserves the right to refuse admission or remove any individual or group of individuals who do or have in the past violated posted park rules.

General Rules

- Profanity, theft, or fighting will not be tolerated. Violators will be permanently barred from the park.
- Smoking is allowed only on the front porch outside the park or in the grass area by the blue pavilion.
- Glass containers are not allowed in the park. All bags, coolers and containers will be inspected at the entrance.
- No running or diving allowed anywhere in the park.
- Obey life guards and safety signs. Anyone disobeying a life guard or a safety sign will be barred from the park for the remainder of the day.
- Swimming suits with any metal objects on them will not be allowed to ride the slides or the lazy river. Management reserves the right to determine if a swimming suit is acceptable
- Alcohol is not permitted in the park.
- Children 12 year or younger must be accompanied by an adult.

Health /Public Safety Rules

- Children under 3 years old must stay in the Kiddies Pool. They are not allowed in the main pool, on the slides, or in the lazy river.
- Children under 3 years old must wear "Swimmers" diapers, children under 3 not wearing "Swimmers" diapers will not be allowed in the Kiddies Pool.
- All diapers and swimmers must be changed in the changing/restroom area only! Anyone who changes a diaper/swimmer in the pool area leaves a diaper/swimmer on the ground, or puts them in a pool area trash can will be asked to leave the park without a refund.
- Parents are responsible for their children at all times.
- Sliding head first on any slide is prohibited.
- Children taller than 42 inches are not allowed on the kiddie's pool slides. Running in the park is prohibited at all times.
- Rules are subject to change, rules on this site may not always be current. Pay attention the signs posted within the park. There are other general rules posted within the park which pertain to specific areas, such as the Slides and Lazy River.

Rules & Safety

- The following rules have been put in place to help insure the safety of our guests as well as the park staff. Please follow these rules so everyone may enjoy a fun and safe day. Lost Island reserves the right to deny access to its facilities to individuals who refuse to obey rules or personnel.
- Please adhere to lifeguard instructions at all times; our lifeguards are certified.
- Swim attire with rivets, buckles or exposed metal is not permitted on the attractions.
- Leave valuables such as jewelry at home or in your hotel.
- No coolers or glass containers inside park.
- No running, diving, or horseplay.
- Ride specific rules are located near each attraction. Some have certain age/height requirements.
- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.
- Diaper age children must wear plastic pants or swim diapers.
- Tubes are free and located in tube corrals near each slide. Please do not drag tubes around the park.
- Protect your feet on extremely warm days; the deck can get very hot.
- Outside tubes or flotation toys are not allowed.
- Clear tubes in Tsunami Bay are for your safety. These tubes aid our staff in scanning the pool floor. Please keep colored tubes out of the Tsunami Bay area.

Height Restrictions for Waterslides

- Waialua Kapuas Must be 42" tall to ride.
- Tá Katipo No height restrictions
- Molokini Crater Must be 48" tall to ride.
- Calypso Cascade No height restrictions
- Tangerine Tempest Must be 48" tall to ride.
- Kiwi Koaster Riders under 48" tall must be accompanied by an adult.
- Lost Soul Falls Must be 48" tall to ride.
- Polynesian Plunge & Samoan Splash Must be 48" tall to ride.

- Emerald Adventure & Jade Rapids Riders under 48" tall must be accompanied by an adult.
